




Wyldø Flowers ~ Quilt Block



You will need:




2 ½" hard plastic template
Fabric – small to med print
Usual sewing tools
Rotary Cutter
Small to mini cutting mat
Iron

Yardage: (wof = 20")

	Light	- Fat Quarter (15½" x 20")
	Pink	- Fat Quarter (13" x 20")
	Dark	- Two Fat Quarters (20½" x 20")

Cutting Directions:

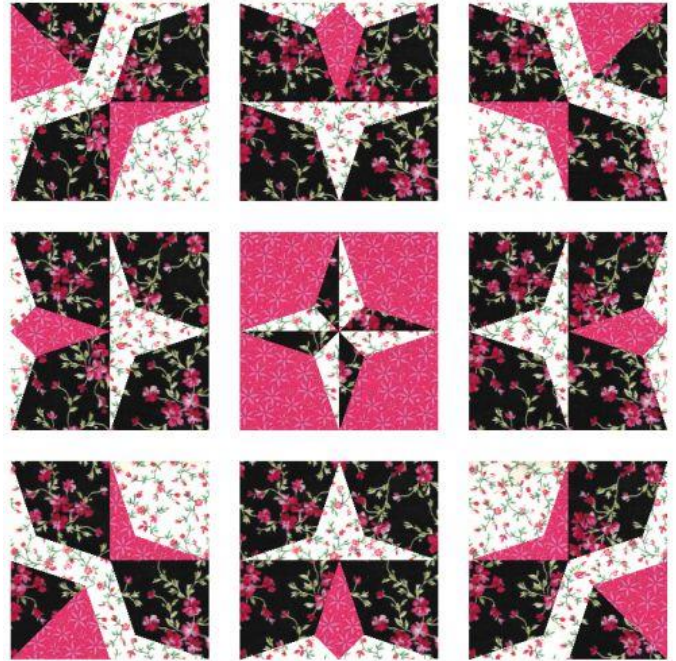
Wings Blocks

-  **Light –**
One Strip – 3½" x wof (Top)
Four Strips – 3" x wof (Bottom)
-  **Pink –**
Two Strips – 3½" x wof (Top)
Two Strips – 3" x wof (Bottom)
-  **Dark –**
Five Strips – 3½" x wof (Top)
One Strip – 3" x wof (Bottom)

Refer to the Wings Shortcut block directions in the Shortcut Blocks Tab



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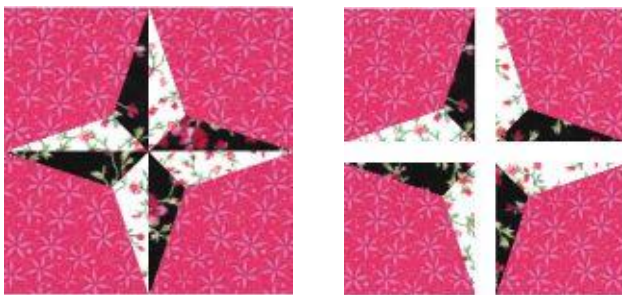
Corners



Above left here you can see the BOM quilt block. On the right here is the layout showing you how all of the blocks lay in the layout.

Make sure you have all the colors in the right position and you have the blocks turned the right direction.

Center



I like to break the quilt block into 4 patches. Or you can sew the blocks into rows then sew the rows together.

1st step:

Sew all 4 of the corner 4 Patches

2nd step

Sew all 4 of the Middle 4 patches

3rd step

Sew the center 4 patch

4th step

Sew all of the 4 patches into rows
According to the layout above
